The goal is to provide the tools needed to transition back into society in a positive and self-sufficient manner. We offer holistic programs with classes covering every aspect of life. Men learn to be better husbands/fathers. Women with children can learn how to be better mothers. Women whose children have been taken away will have an opportunity to reconnect with their children in a safe environment. Case management is the first step in determining the needs of each.
