Job Description:

Required to drive vehicles with a capacity up to two tons or less; transport material/goods and or donations to and from specified locations as needed; read maps and follow written and verbal geographic directions; obey traffic laws and follow established traffic and transportation procedures; report all transportation delays, accidents, and or other traffic and transportation situations to the Fleet Services Manager, (or designed authorized personnel) using a telephone, cellular phone or two-way radios. Will also use Mission equipment to load and unload trucks, vans and automobiles of material goods, or donated items; carries donated items to various departments/campuses of the Mission; helps other staff with items to be lifted or transferred. Performs all other duties as assigned by supervisor. Security-makes sure property is kept safe & secure.

Requirements:

High School diploma required; minimum of **(2) years minimum of thrift store experience, sorting, pricing and organizing donations is a must!** experience in related field; forklift experience recommended, but not required; Class C License recommended with a Clean Driving Record (but not required; DMV Printout Required); be able to communicate effectively with co-workers, and the general public; demonstrate a Christ-like behavior and attitude in all duties and responsibilities; perform all job functions per the employer's expectations and comply with all conditions, terms of employment.

We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ, with equality across racial, gender and class differences. (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 2:13-14).
